September Newsletter



September is the month when people start thinking about organizing, cleaning and maintaining their homes and offices. Some of you are getting ready to downsize, thinking of selling your homes and need to pack and prepare for selling and moving. Many people e-mail me and ask me how to organize their clothes closet. Here are my 10 simple tips to conquer your clothes closet clutter.

1. Get good quality hangers, either plastic or wood, one colour for the uniform look or, if you are sharing closet space with someone, get one colour for yourself and another for the other person.
2. Start with a clean slate. Pull everything out that lives in your closet down to a safety pin. Keep in mind that we only wear 20% of our clothes 80% of the time.
3. Get rid of any clothes that are stained, ripped or stretched.
4. Have a pile for the clothes that you don't like or don't fit. Donate them to your favourite charity. Have a pile for the clothes you are keeping.
5. Save any clothes that need mending for two weeks, if not fixed, throw them out.
6. Organize the clothes you are keeping in a few categories: pants, skirts, t-shirts and blouses.
7. Install a few hooks on your wall, or your closet door, for your belts, necklaces, robes and purses.
8. Buy attractive baskets and place them on the top shelf of your closet for your scarves, hats and gloves.
9. Place a shoe rack under your clothes for the special occasion shoes.
10. Word of caution: Don't overstuff your closet. Make sure you have easy access to your clothes and accessories. The goal here is quality, not quantity. Remember, for every new item you buy; remove one or two old items.
